Spring is here, and after many years of below average rainfall we have enjoyed some wonderful early season rainfall this year. The vineyard is a rich emerald green colour, with the Shiraz vines in front of our house growing so fast we sometimes feel that they have visibly grown between breakfast and lunch! Our fourth season here at Twisted Gum Vineyard is shaping up to be a very good one. ☺

In the Vineyard

Michelle and I have had a very busy few months in the vineyard. We have spread 25 tonnes of composted manure and 200 cubic metres of mulch under the vines. It was lots of hard work but our soils will really benefit from all of this wonderful organic matter.

We have also taken advantage of the excellent soil moisture, and planted 200 Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon and Chardonnay rootlings in the gaps in some of our vineyard blocks (when we took on this vineyard in 2007 it had many gaps because of the effects of three consecutive years of drought and a bushfire). The planting was all done by hand and my back really knew it when I had finished digging 200 holes! – but it is very rewarding to see the new vines slowly working their way up to the cordon wire.
