Winter on the Granite Belt has been nice and chilly as usual, with a number of heavy frosts making the grass crunchy underfoot. We have had lots of guests in Twisted Gum Vineyard Cottage enjoying the Brass Monkey Season up here, with the wood heater in the cottage keeping everyone warm and toasty at night.

In the Vineyard

Winter is pruning time, which means long days in the vineyard for Michelle and I - and stiff hands from pruning over 5,000 vines! However, we have found pruning to be much easier in 2010 because the majority of the spurs are now pointing upwards. In each of the past three seasons we have spent a lot of time carefully pruning our vines to remove any spurs that are not pointing upwards and encouraging new vertical spurs to replace them. This is crucial for the Vertical Shoot Positioning (VSP) system that we use in our vineyard, where in the growing season all the canes are positioned vertically and are supported by foliage wires. This structure allows the breezes to

pass through the foliage to reduce disease and also allows the sunlight to fully ripen the grapes.

Winestate Magazine's World's Greatest Shiraz Challenge

Twisted Gum Wines entered two wines in the Winestate Magazine *World's Greatest Shiraz/Syrah Challenge* recently and won awards for both wines! The competition was held at the National Wine Centre in Adelaide on June 18 and involved in excess of 700 Shiraz and Shiraz blend wines from all over Australia and New Zealand. We received Four Stars (equivalent to a Silver Medal) for our 2009 Shiraz and Three Stars (equivalent to a Bronze Medal) for our 2008 Shiraz Cabernet. This is a fantastic result, which shows that Granite Belt Shiraz can match it with the best of them. ©
