Four Stars from James Halliday!!

We are very excited to announce that Twisted Gum Wines has been awarded a four star rating in James Halliday's 2014 Australian Wine *Companion*!! This is great news for us. A four star rating is very difficult to achieve. A winery must have two or more of their wines rated at 90 points or above to obtain a four star rating. We are a tiny winery, producing only six wines (600 cases in total each year), so this is an outstanding result for us, especially given that we have only been producing wines since 2008.

In fact, the Granite Belt has done very well this year in the 2014 Australian Wine Companion, with eight of our 45 wineries now rated at 4 stars or above. This is very impressive, and shows that the Granite Belt is a seriously good wine region with ratings like these from Australia's most well respected wine critic. The Granite Belt has three 5 star wineries: Boirean, Golden Grove Estate and Symphony Hill Wines, and five 4 star wineries: Ballandean Estate, Ravenscroft Wines, Ridgemill Estate, Tobin Wines and Twisted Gum Wines. Now if you visit four wineries per day, that sounds like a pretty good way to spend a weekend. ©

Join Tim and Michelle Coelli on a leisurely stroll through their picturesque, hand tended vineyard. Admire the lush green vines set among stunning granite boulders and impressive twisted gum trees. Discuss how to grow, prune and harvest grape vines so that they produce the highest quality wines possible. Press Tim and Michelle for the secrets to the success of their sustainable vineyard practices, involving the use of birdlife to replace pesticides and careful mulching instead of irrigation. Then return to their stylish cellar door (in a classic 1920?s Queenslander with wrap around verandas on three sides) to enjoy a guided tasting of single vineyard, dry grown Twisted Gum Wines matched with local artisan cheeses on the veranda as the sunsets.
